Code of Conduct

As a condition of membership, members are asked to abide by the following Code of Conduct.

Respect for Others

Members are to respect the rights, dignity and worth of other gardeners and visitors regardless of their culture, age, abilities, gender, religion, or cultural background.

Behaviour

All members are to behave with integrity in their dealings with others. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated. This includes:

- Swearing or yelling.
- Sexually suggestive comments / jokes.
- Racist comments / jokes.



- Using Derogatory language or making insensitive comments.
- Violent or aggressive behaviour
- Bullying, Harassing, Humiliating, or Intimidating others.

Disciplinary action, suspension or termination of membership may result from repeated inappropriate behaviour. Wherever possible, disagreements between members should be settled between themselves calmly and amicably. If this is not possible the TCOGA conflict resolution and grievance procedures should be followed.

General

- Members must be committed to and comply with the general gardening principles and all operational requirements as set out in the TCOGA membership handbook.
- TCOGA values the time and input of its volunteer members. It is an expectation that all members will spend time helping with the maintenance of communal areas and/or by participating in working bees and/or fund-raising activities.
- Members are asked to carry out their responsibilities to the best of their abilities according to their role requirements. As gardening is a continuous life learning activity, members should be flexible and open to new ideas and actively seek to learn from others.
- Gardeners should not knowingly introduce weedy, prohibited, or diseased plants to the garden.
- Garden plots and their boundaries must be kept free of weeds and grass.
- All activities within the garden must be conducted in a safe manner. Pathways and access routes should be kept clear to ensure there are no physical barriers to participation.
